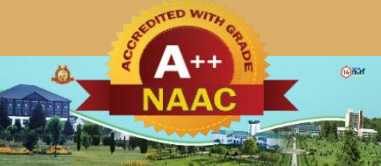


GUIDELINES FOR ABSTRACT SUBMISSION

Each registrant can submit one or two **abstracts** as a first author or a presenter. Abstracts must be prepared in **MS Word** with the following specifications:

- **Paper size:** A4
- **Font:** Times New Roman
- **Font size:** 12
- **Line spacing:** 1.15
- **Margins:** 1.7
- Avoid using any special symbols, formulas, diagrams, tables, or references
- The abstract should include the following sections in order:
 - **Title:** Maximum of 30 words (**Bold**)
 - **Author(s) Name(s)**
 - **Affiliation(s)**
 - **Email address** of the corresponding author
 - **Abstract body:** Maximum of 300 words
 - **Keywords:** Up to 5 only (*Italic separated by semicolon*)
- The abstract body text should be **justified** (aligned evenly on both sides)

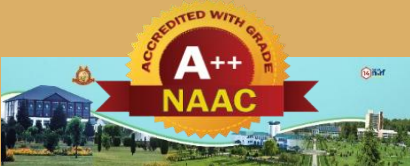

IGI has instituted an award for the best paper presented by a single author up to the age of 35 years. The young scholars who want to be considered for the award are advised to register for the event and submit full original paper. The award carries a certificate and token honorarium.

To participate in the young geomorphologists competition, the candidate should:

- submit abstract as a single author
- be less than 35 years of age (attach proof of birth date)
- recommendation letter from the supervisor or the Head of the department
- submit a brief CV not exceeding two pages

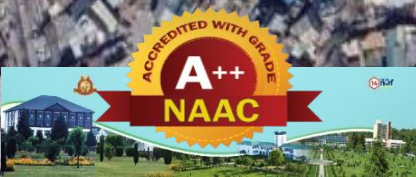


DEPARTMENT OF GEOGRAPHY & DISASTER MANAGEMENT

With the launch of a specialized postgraduate programme in Disaster Management in 2014, it was aptly renamed as “[Department of Geography & Disaster Management](#)” in 2021, reflecting its broad academic scope and relevance.

The Department of Geography & Disaster Management at the University of Kashmir is one of the pioneering academic centers in the region, offering postgraduate and doctoral programs. Srinagar is also famous for its handicrafts, including Pashmina shawls, Kashmiri carpets, and intricately carved wooden items. The city's floating markets on Dal Lake, where vendors sell flowers, fruits, and local produce on boats, are a distinctive cultural practice. With its striking natural scenery, rich heritage, and warm hospitality, Srinagar remains one of the most enchanting destinations in the world.
